Data Elements to ASB access and participation

By January 15, 2020, each school district that operates one or more high schools must submit to OSPI confirmation that the ASB program information required by RCW 28A.325.050 is published online, and must include the website address where the ASB fund information can be found. The law requires OSPI to publish a list of districts that are out of compliance by January 15, 2020.

Also by January 15, 2020, each school district with a high school must collect, report to their ASB executive board, and publish on their website additional data elements related to ASB access and participation (see Table 1 below). OSPI recommends posting this information to the same website page that includes the information required by RCW 28A.325.050.

The law also requires OSPI, by December 30, 2020, to publish a list of schools and districts that are out of compliance with RCW 28A.325.010—Fees for optional noncredit extracurricular events. More information for this to be released by OSPI in 2020.
