Make this an enjoyable and stress-free year by following this handy timeline:

NOW	Purchase your 2022 Yearbook. Login here and shop/purchase. Purchase before December 31st for best price (\$40). All pre-orders must be made by Feb 25th.
June - August	Get senior pictures taken (preferably before school starts to avoid the rush on photographers and the hectic school schedule)
August	Buy your yearbook online starting 8/2 at <u>hocksd.org</u> , OR during registration (go to Payments → Pay Fees and Fines → login to Skyward and purchase yearbook).
November 5th, 2021	Senior Portraits and senior quotes are due! No exceptions. See information below for requirements and how to submit.
November - January	Get your Throwback Ad organized
January 3rd - 7th, 2022 Throwback Ad \$30 (See details below)	Purchase your Throwback Ad online or in the HHS Activities Office between these dates. First come, first served. Space is limited and some years we sell out fast. Remaining parts of the Throwback Ad must be submitted by January 7th. Digital submission of photo/message does not guarantee your spot it is only your purchase that does. Pay online HERE or at HHS (cash or check M-F 12:00-4:00). Senior Quotes: Due November 5th, 2021

Seniors must email their quote to jennifer.brinkman@hocksd.org with the subject "senior quote." Late submissions will not be accepted, as our yearbook runs by strict publication deadlines. If the quote is rejected for not following the requirements, no quote will be included for that senior, as it is too difficult with yearbook deadlines to provide individual notices and wait for resubmissions.

Remember, senior quotes are a way to leave a fun, positive, lasting impression or piece of advice that will be read for years to come by the community. Make it a great one!

STOP AND CHECK BEFORE YOU "SEND"	Is the name of the senior, first and last, attached visibly to the email?
BEFORE TOU SEND	 Does the quote meet the following requirements? Must be a single short quote from someone famous or well known that can be validated on the internet through a credible source. No numbers, initials, codes, or abbreviations will be allowed. Must be appropriate with no questionable content. If the quote can be taken the wrong way (such as implications related to sex, drugs/alcohol, violence, etc.), it will not be included. Must be positive (no put downs toward anyone will be allowed). Must be a reasonable length of no more than approximately 20 words. No inside jokes. Everyone who reads the yearbook must understand the quote, as it is written for the purpose of the whole community to enjoy.

Throwback Ad (\$30): On sale January 3rd - 7th (may close before the 7th if sold out)

Throwback Ads are a way for families to honor seniors. Not sure what it is? Take a look at the back of a yearbook. You can create a special message for your senior! We invite you to send a "throwback" picture of your senior in younger days with a typed statement that will appear in their senior yearbook. Each ad will be 1/8 of a yearbook page in size and **cost \$30**.

HOW TO SUBMIT (Digital Submission)	By January 7th. Remaining parts of the ad must be submitted by January 7th. Digital submission of photo/message does not guarantee your spot only your payment does.
